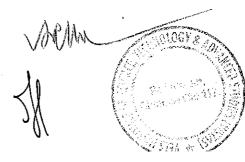

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GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

§1 SUBJECT MATTER

- 1. In connection with the performance of the Master Agreement executed by the Parties, as specified in the Specific Terms and Conditions, the Controller entrusts the Processor with the processing, on its behalf, of only the Personal Data regarding the Data Subjects specified in the Specific Terms and Conditions, for the purposes and term and with the methods as specified in the Specific Terms and Conditions.
- 2. The Controller, as the controller of Personal Data, maintains full control over such data, i.e., it alone determines the purposes and means of Personal Data processing.
- 3. Entrusting of Personal Data under the Agreement is necessary for performance of the Master Agreement.
- 4. The Processor guarantees the implementation of adequate technical and organisational measures especially in terms of its expert knowledge, reliability and resources so that the processing of Personal Data entrusted to it conforms with applicable regulation on the protection of personal data.
- 5. The existing terms of entrusting the Processor with the processing of Personal Data controlled by the Controller, in performance of the Master Agreement, as specified therein and, additionally, in separate agreements or contracts made by the Parties cease to be valid as of the execution date hereof.

§2 DEFINITIONS

- The terms used herein shall be construed in accordance with their meaning: (i) as defined in the relevant provisions of the European Union "GDPR" (Global Data Protection Regulation); and (ii) as defined herein:
 - 1) Authorised Processing Subcontractor means the Processing Subcontractor of the Processor which: (i) guarantees conformance with the terms of commissioned processing as defined in

the Agreement; and (ii) was approved by the Controller at the execution hereof and is listed in Appendix 3 to the Agreement;

- 2) Personal Data means information or identifiers specified in the Specific Terms and Conditions in the column entitled "Types of Personal Data", relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (hereinafter referred to as "Data Subject"), being the subject hereof;
- Business Day means any day from Monday through Friday, except for any public holidays and statutory days off work in the country of Data Controller's registered office;
- 4) Personal Data Breach means any breach of security leading to the accidental and/or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure of, and/or access to, Personal Data transmitted, stored and/or otherwise processed;
- 5) Supervisory Authority means an independent public authority appointed to protect the fundamental rights and freedoms of natural persons in relation to data processing;
- 6) Intentionally deleted;
- 7) Processor means the entity being a party hereof, as specified in the preamble, entrusted by the Controller with the processing of Personal Data on the basis and upon the terms as specified in the Agreement;
- 8) Processing Subcontractor means the processing subcontractor entrusted by the Processor with further processing of Personal Data, in compliance with the terms and conditions as specified in § 3 clause 15 and clause 17 hereof;
- 9) Specific Terms and Conditions –individual provisions of the Agreement relating to the scope and terms of entrusting data processing as agreed between the Controller and the Processor and specifying the types of Personal Data, the categories of Data Subjects, the purpose of entrusting data processing as well as

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If the Processor is not able to provide the Controller with all the information referred to in the items above within the time period set in the first sentence of clause 7 above, the Processor should provide the missing information, after first consulting with the Controller in Working Mode, within additional time as set by the Controller.

- The Processor warrants that it shall actively cooperate with the Controller so that it is able to properly fulfil its obligation to notify the Personal Data Breach to the Supervisory Authority.
- 9. The Processor represents that it shall bear the full costs of any remedial action taken in response to the Personal Data Breach if it results from any action and/or omission on the part of the Processor, its employees, associates and/or other persons and Processing Subcontractors.
- 10. The Processor shall be required to document any and all circumstances of a Personal Data Breach, its effects and preventive measures taken. The Processor shall be required to provide access, at each and every request of the Controller, to the documents referred to in the foregoing sentence.

Data Subject's Rights

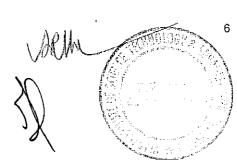
- 11. The Processor warrants that, where applicable, it shall:
 - 11 Each time, immediately notify Controller in Working Mode, to the extent permitted pursuant to the provisions of law in effect, of any request received in relation to Personal Data or access to such data and consult with the Controller the contents of its response to such a request (if required), irrespective of the entity, organisation, association, authority, court or person placing the request, including Data Subjects, and, if need be, provide the Controller with necessary assistance to meet the legal requirements regarding the protection of Personal Data;
 - 2) Each time, immediately forward to the Controller, in Working Mode, the request of the Data Subjects related to the rectification or erasure of Personal Data or

- restriction of processing, transfer, updating, modification or removal of Personal Data;
- Each time, immediately forward to the Controller, in Working Mode, any objection of the Data Subject against his/ her data being processed or any other objection so communicated;
- Each time, immediately communicate to the Controller, in Working Mode, the withdrawal by Data Subject of any consent granted to the Controller for marketing communication;
- 5) At each and every request of the Controller, immediately take measures to observe the rights of the Data Subject as stipulated in as specified in Articles 12 through 23 of the GDPR with the use of adequate technical and organisational measures and taking into account the information it holds and the nature of Personal Data processing, and, in particular, the means and technologies used in such processing;
- 6) At each and every request of the Controller, immediately rectify, update, modify or remove Personal Data.

Obligation to assist the Controller

- 12. If need be, at the request of the Controller, the Processor shall be required to assist the Controller in providing for the observance of the requirements set in Articles 32 through 36 of the GDPR (taking into account the nature of processing and the information available to the Processor due to the scope actions performed in Personal Data processing), relating to:
 - 1) The adequate technical and organisational measures taken;
 - 2) Personal Data Breach notification;
 - 3) Cornmunication of a Personal Data Breach to data subjects;
 - 4) The assessment of any and all risks pertinent to Personal Data processing and possible safeguards and mechanisms to be implemented to: (i) eliminate or mitigate the aforementioned risks; (ii)

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If the Processor is not able to provide the Controller with all the information referred to in the items above within the time period set in the first sentence of clause 7 above, the Processor should provide the missing information, after first consulting with the Controller in Working Mode, within additional time as set by the Controller.

- 9. The Processor represents that it shall bear the full costs of any remedial action taken in response to the Personal Data Breach if it results from any action and/or omission on the part of the Processor, its employees, associates and/or other persons and Processing Subcontractors.
- 10. The Processor shall be required to document any and all circumstances of a Personal Data Breach, its effects and preventive measures taken. The Processor shall be required to provide access, at each and every request of the Controller, to the documents referred to in the foregoing sentence.

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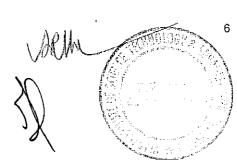
- 11. The Processor warrants that, where applicable, it shall:
 - 11 Each time, immediately notify Controller in Working Mode, to the extent permitted pursuant to the provisions of law in effect, of any request received in relation to Personal Data or access to such data and consult with the Controller the contents of its response to such a request (if required), irrespective of the entity, organisation, association, authority, court or person placing the request, including Data Subjects, and, if need be, provide the Controller with necessary assistance to meet the legal requirements regarding the protection of Personal Data;
 - 2) Each time, immediately forward to the Controller, in Working Mode, the request of the Data Subjects related to the rectification or erasure of Personal Data or

- restriction of processing, transfer, updating, modification or removal of Personal Data;
- Each time, immediately forward to the Controller, in Working Mode, any objection of the Data Subject against his/ her data being processed or any other objection so communicated;
- Each time, immediately communicate to the Controller, in Working Mode, the withdrawal by Data Subject of any consent granted to the Controller for marketing communication;
- 5) At each and every request of the Controller, immediately take measures to observe the rights of the Data Subject as stipulated in as specified in Articles 12 through 23 of the GDPR with the use of adequate technical and organisational measures and taking into account the information it holds and the nature of Personal Data processing, and, in particular, the means and technologies used in such processing;
- 6) At each and every request of the Controller, immediately rectify, update, modify or remove Personal Data.

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 - 1) The adequate technical and organisational measures taken;
 - 2) Personal Data Breach notification;
 - 3) Cornmunication of a Personal Data Breach to data subjects;
 - 4) The assessment of any and all risks pertinent to Personal Data processing and possible safeguards and mechanisms to be implemented to: (i) eliminate or mitigate the aforementioned risks; (ii)

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- warrant adequate level of Personal Data security; (iii) take into account the state of the art, the cost of implementation versus the aforementioned risks and the nature of the Personal Data to be protected;
- 5) Prior consultations with the Supervisory Authority.

Cooperation with the Controller

- 13. The Processor shall be required to:
 - Provide the Controller with any and all information necessary to demonstrate the fulfilment of obligations set out in Article 28 of the GDPR;
 - 2) Render it possible for the Controller or an auditor authorised by the Controller to make audits, including inspections, and take an active part in them.
- 14.in the event that the Controller undergoes any inspection performed by the Supervisory Authority, the Processor shall be required to actively cooperate with the Controller and the Supervisory Authority.

Processing Subcontractor

- 15.The Processor may entrust its processing subcontractor with further processing of Personal Data in performance of the Agreement, subject to a prior, detailed, written consent of the Controller. The foregoing shall not apply to the Authorised Processing Subcontractors approved by the Controller at the execution hereof, as listed in Appendix 3 to the Agreement.
- 16.A company, being a member of the same group of companies as the Processor, which may be engaged by the Processor to render the services hereunder and obtain access to Personal Data for the purpose of processing the same shall be considered to be the Processing Subcontractor to whom the provisions of § 3 clause 15 and clause 17 hereof shall apply.
- 17.The Processor warrants to:
 - execute with the Processing Subcontractor approved by the Controller in accordance with clause 15 above, in writing, a data processing agreement in relation to the Personal Data and solely

- upon the terms of, in the scope of and for the purpose of data processing under and for the term corresponding to the term of the Agreement;
- 2) Impose on the Processing Subcontractor, on the basis of the agreement referred to in item 1) above, the obligation to process Personal Data only on behalf of and in accordance with the instructions of the Controller, and fulfil the obligation to protect Personal Data in a manner that warrants the level of security not lower that that provided hereunder, in order to warrant that the Processing Subcontractor fulfils all of its data protection obligations in compliance with the Agreement and, in particular, those related to the provision of guarantee for sufficient implementation of adequate technical and organisational measures for ensuring processing compliance with the provisions of the GDPR and the protection of data subjects' rights;
- 3) Immediately provide a copy of the agreements referred to in item 1) above, at the request of the Controller, as well as the description of safety measures implemented by the Processing Subcontractors, subject to the option of first removing from such agreements any and all irrelevant, commercial information of no material significance in evaluating the fulfilment of the Processor's obligations related to the engagement of Processing Subcontractors.
- 18.The Controllershall be required to treat as confidential any and all documents, materials and information delivered by the Processor pursuant to clause 17 items 1) and 3) above, unless and to the extent that the Controlleris not required to disclose the same in response to a demand by the Supervisory Authority, a court or a Data Subject.

§4 Audit

 The Controller reserves the right to freely perform or commission the performance, at any time, of an audit, including inspections, which it deems to be necessary to confirm the fulfilment by the Processor or its

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Processing Subcontractors of the obligations and guarantees as stipulated in the Agreement.

- 2. The Processor agrees, in particular, to:
 - 1) Take part in the audit at its own cost;
 - 2) Deliver, at each and every request of the Controller, within 5 Business Daysof receipt of the request, in a manner agreed with the Controller in a Working Mode, any and all information, materials, documents or any other information resources held by it in relation to the Personal Data processing, as necessary for the Controller to demonstrate its compliance with the obligations arising from personal data protection legislation;
 - Provide, if necessary, access to its registered office and that of its Processing Subcontractors for audit purposes;
 - 4) Provide, subject to the observance of business secrets, at the place of performing an audit, access to:
 - a) any and all information, materials, documents or any other information resources held by it in relation to the Personal Data processing, as necessary for the Controller to demonstrate its compliance with the obligations arising from personal data protection legislation; and,
 - b) If necessary, also the hardware, software, data, files, IT systems, documents and any other information resources used in Personal Data processing;
- 3. If the audit demonstrates that the Processor or any of its Processing Subcontractors violates any guarantee or obligation arising from personal data protection legislation, the Processor shall be required to take, without undue delay and at its own cost, necessary actions or measures to discontinue the breach and reduce any potentially adverse effects thereof. The audits completed or the results thereof do not release the Processor from its obligations under the Agreement.

§5Monitoring and improving standards of Personal Data safety and confidentiality

- The Processor shall appoint a contact person responsible for responding to any queries, requests or orders by the Controller in relation to the protection of Personal Data. If possible, the contact person so appointed should be qualified in the field of personal data protection.
- 2. The Processor agrees to permanently improve, if possible, its knowledge of personal data protection in order to refine the technical and organisational measures or safeguards that are designed to warranty the safety of Personal Data at the level adequate to the risk existing thought the entire term of the Agreement.

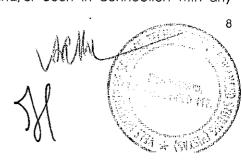
§6 Intentionally deleted

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§7 Processor's liability

- The Processor shall be liable for any material and non-material damage inflicted upon the Controller and Data Subjects as a result of any breach of personal data protection legislation in connection with the performance of the Agreement in compliance with the provisions hereof and the provisions of the applicable regulation.
- 2. The Processor shall be liable for the actions and omissions of its employees, associates or other persons and Processing Subcontractors the assistance of which it uses in performing this Agreement as it is liable for its own actions and omissions.
- 3. In the event that any other Processing Subcontractor whom the Processor entrusted with Personal Data processing hereunder fails to fulfil its data protection obligations arising from the agreement executed with the Processor or personal data protection legislation, the Processor shall be fully liable towards the Controller on that account.
- 4. In the event that any fine and/or penalty payment is imposed on or adjudicated against the Controller by the Supervisory Authority, any other public administration body and/or court in connection with any

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breach of personal data protection legislation, stemming, either directly and/or indirectly, from any failure of the Processor or its Processing Subcontractor to fulfil or duly fulfil its data protection obligations, the Processor shall pay the Controller the equivalent of such fine or penalty payment made by the Controller and, additionally, cover any and all other costs incurred by the Controller in connection with proceedings in which the fine and/or penalty payment was imposed on the Controller. Additionally, the Processor shall be required to actively cooperate with the Controller in the course of such proceedings in order to effectively dismiss claims or remove the breach and mitigate any potentially adverse effects thereof.

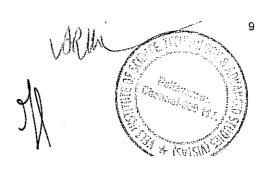
- 5. Notwithstanding clause 4 above, in the event that the Supervisory Authority imposes on the Controller any of the measures referred to in Article 58 (2) letters a) through h) of the GDPR in respect of any breach of personal data protection legislation, stemming, either directly or indirectly, from any failure of the Processor or its Processing Subcontractor to fulfil or duly fulfil its data protection obligations, the Processor shall cover any and all costs incurred by the Controller in connection with the proceedings in which the aforementioned measures were imposed on the Controller and in connection with the implementation thereof. Additionally, the Processor shall be required to actively cooperate with the Controller in the course of such proceedings in order to effectively dismiss claims and/or remove the breach and mitigate any potentially adverse effects thereof.
- 6. In the event that any Data Subject or third party, any other entity, organisation or association referred to in Article 80 of the GDPR asserts any claim for compensation, damages or any other amounts in court proceedings or out of court in connection with any breach of personal data protection legislation, in connection with any unlawful processing of Personal Data by the Processor or its Processing Subcontractor in breach of the Agreement, the Processor shall indemnify

- the Controller against any and all claims asserted against the Controller and hold the Controller harmless of any such liability, including the reimbursement of any costs and amounts paid by the Controller to the injured party, and additionally, cover any and all losses and expenses incurred by the Controller in connection with the claims lodged against it.
- 7. Irrespective of the Processor's obligations as stipulated in this paragraph, the Controller shall have the right to call the Processor to pay liquidated damages for the Processor's breach of the Personal Data processing obligations and principles provided for hereunder, the event that the Supervisory Authority, any Data Subject or third party, any other entity, organisation or association referred to in Article 80 of the GDPR takes any measures as a result of such breach or exercises any powers as stipulated in the GDPR, in the amount of 50 000EURfor each and every instance of such breach. The liquidated damages so reserved do not exclude the possibility of the Controller seeking damages from the Processor on general terms, in the amount exceeding the amount of the reserved liquidated damages. The liquidated damages referred to in this clause shall be payable at first demand, within 14 Business Daysof receipt of such demand.

§8 Term of the Agreement

- Subject to the provisions of clause 2 below, this Agreement is concluded for the term of the Master Agreement and expires upon the lapse of the notice period or upon the termination of the Master Agreement.
- 2. If the Processor is required to continue the processing of Personal Data in connection with the termination or cancellation of the Master Agreement (e.g. in order for the Processor to duly fulfil all of its obligations towards the Controller arising from the Master Agreement, and, in particular, within the scope of any after-sales services to the

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Controller subscribers), the Agreement shall remain valid until the time period for which the Personal Data processing is entrusted elapses, as specified in the Specific Terms and Conditions.

- 3. The termination of Master Agreement shall trigger the Agreement's termination, provided, however, that the provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full effect until the time period for which the Personal Data processing is entrusted elapses, as specified in the Specific Terms and Conditions.
- 4. If the Processor notifies the Controller of any obstacle preventing it from duly performing the Agreement, and, in particular, its inability to fulfil any Personal Data protection obligation as specified in the Agreement, the Controller shall have the right to suspend the Agreement performance in full or in any part, or terminate the Agreement with an immediate effect, without the Processor's right to any compensation. For the avoidance of any doubt, it is agreed that the Agreement terminated in such manner shall trigger the termination of Master Agreement, unless the Controller resolves otherwise.
- 5. The Controller shall have the right to terminate the Agreement in the event of the Processor's or Processing Subcontractor's failure to fulfil any Personal Data protection obligation arising pursuant to the Agreement, with an immediate effect and without the Processor's right to any compensation, upon first calling the Processor to cure the aforementioned breach of the Agreement within a prescribed time period and following the lapse of such time period. The Controller shall be entitled to suspend the Agreement performance in full or in any part for the time period set in the call referred to in the foregoing sentence. For the avoidance of any doubt, it is agreed that the Agreement terminated in such manner shall trigger the termination of Master Agreement, unless the Controller resolves otherwise.
- 6. If Personal Data processing is discontinued in connection with the Agreement termination or cancellation, the Processor shall be

required, at the discretion of the Controller, to:

- 1) destroy or permanently remove and provide for its Processing Subcontractors to destroy or permanently remove any and all Personal Data entrusted for processing, any and all documents and data carriers containing such data as well as any records in IT systems and software or any manual catalogues and files in which the data is stored; or
- 2) return to the Controller the Personal Data entrusted for processing in a universally used format as agreed with the Controller in Working Mode, no copy thereof being kept by the Processor or any of its Processing Subcontractors.
- 7. The Processor shall also be required to submit to the Controller, within 3 Business Daysof completion of the actions specified in clause 6 items 1) or 2) above, a written statement to confirm the destruction or permanent removal of the Personal Data entrusted for processing or attest that neither the Processor nor any of its Processing Subcontractors hold any Personal Data obtained from the Controller, or rendered available to them via the Controller systems in connection with the Agreement performance, unless generally applicable provisions of law impose the Processor or its **Processing** Subcontractors the obligation to store Personal Data.

§9 Miscellaneous

- 1. This Agreement becomes effective on the day of signing by the Parties.
- In the event of any conflict between the wording of the General Terms and Conditions and the Specific Terms and Conditions, the Specific Terms and Conditions shall prevail.
- 3. Upon signing the Agreement, either Party may designate from among its employees any persons other than those designated in the Specific Terms and Conditions to be responsible for maintaining day-to-day contacts in matters falling under this

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Agreement and it shall provide the other Party (in the Working Mode) with the data of such persons including the following data: first name, surname, e-mail address, phone numbers and position. The Parties shall immediately inform each other in the Working Mode of any changes in that respect.

- 4. Appendix 3 shall be updated by the Parties in writing, otherwise being deemed null and void, in the form of an implementing arrangement and not an amendment to the Agreement. Statements of will in the scope in question shall be made by the Parties' authorised representatives.
- 5. Paragraph and section headings are inserted for the convenience of use only and do not have any impact on the provisions hereof.

- 6. Intentionally deleted.
- 7. Any and all amendments or supplements to this Agreement shall be made in writing, otherwise they shall be deemed null and void.
- 8. The Parties unanimously declare that in the event of any disputes arising in the course of the Agreement's performance, they shall make endeavours to resolve such disputes amicably. If the Parties fail to resolve a dispute within 30 days of it arising, the dispute shall be referred to a common court with jurisdiction over the registered office of the Controller.
- 9. This Agreement is made in two identical counterparts, one for each Party hereto.
- 10.The Appendices to this Agreement form an integral part hereof.

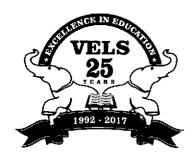
