

Minutes of the Meeting

The XXII Institutional Animal Ethics committee (IAEC) meeting was held 11.02.2019 at 10.30 am at School of Pharmaceutical sciences, VISTAS. The CPCSEA nominces examined the following project proposals submitted to the IAEC and approved /not approved with the following remarks as detailed in annexure I. Based on the observations the following general remarks have to be taken care of during the future project proposal submission.

1. In the project proposal, complete details should be given in the specific places in the format.

2. Certain particulars are left blank / irrelevantly filled. Such things should be avoided in the FORM B

Requested to frame Research Programme Approval Committee to scrutinize the research proposals before being sent to members.

4. All investigators should sign in the proposal

5. Whenever the proposals are based on *in vitro* results, presentation of *in vitro* results is mandatory for approval.

6. Necessary certificate from the vendor should be obtained for the clearance of microbial load

Periodical examination of feed should be carried out for aflatoxin, OPC, nitrate and nitrites. Water should be tested for OPC, nitrates, nitrites and heavy metals. Softness /hardness should be carried out at least once in six months

10. The IAEC (VISTAS), while appreciating the institute in the proper conduct of IAEC meeting as per norms of CPCSEA, requested the management to provide some value addition to the animal house as follows:

a. CCTV camera to be installed at two or three points as per CPCSEA recent notification

Separate holders to hold the PPE to be fixed on the walls.

c. Window to be fixed in the quarantine room

d. Fix a new exhaust fan with louer lock facility

e. Cobwebs to be cleaned in the animal rooms

f. Separate log book should be maintained at the entrance

g. Convert the PPE room and store room into experimental rooms 1 and 2 respectively to avoid the animals to be shifted to

respective departments to maintain environmentally conditioned facility.

h. Convert the space near the entrance into the animal with small partition to keep the feed and bedding material

i. Advised to procure animal racks, polypropylene cages and water bottles afresh.

j. Fix a wash basin near the entrance to wash hands with sterilium.

h. Wall hanger to hang apron

k. Provide dust bins, colour plastic buckets (for disposal of recyclable, plastics, syringes, glass wares etc as per norms), scoop for handling feed and bedding material

I. Requested to fix one RO unit



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In Vels Institute of Science, Technology and Advances Studies, the IQAC recommended the need of Turnitin Software that can be used for checking plagiarism. This tool has been in effective use during the past 3 years. The quantity and quality of research articles have also improved substantially. In the academic year 2018-2019, around 800 articles were checked for plagiarism, whereas in the next academic year close to 2500 articles were checked With the growth in the number of articles checked for plagiarism, IQAC also observed an increase in number of articles with lesser similarity index as in Figure 2. Articles with similarity index less than 25% increased from 127 to 804. The IQAC also ensured that all research articles were checked for plagiarism before submitting the same to journals. The faculty and students send their article to the school and department Turnitin representatives for checking their similarity index. Corrections were made as per the report and papers were submitted only when the similarity report is less than 25 % thereby ensuring quality research articles. Similar to research articles, all the Ph.D. theses were checked for plagiarism and the report was endorsed by the IQAC Coordinator before submission. This ensures that the plagiarism is less than 10 % before the thesis enters into the Shodhganga Database.
