Today, student road safety is given more priority than earlier. Students are the future of a country and hence as a citizen, it is their responsibility to protect them by following the rules and regulations.

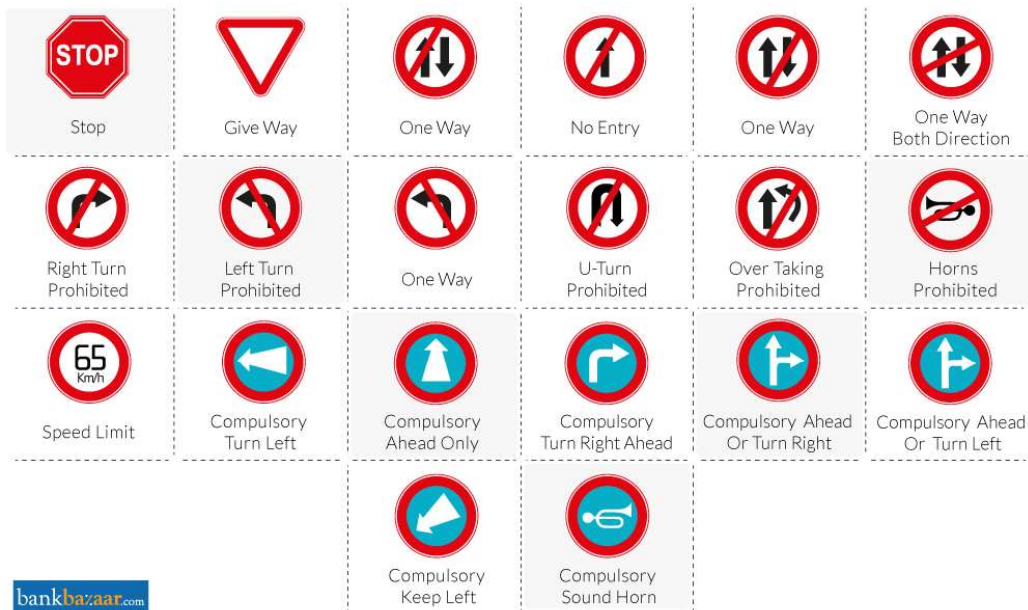
Some of the major causes of road accidents that were highlighted in the awareness programme are as follows.

An Awareness Programme on the Prevention of HIV/AIDS was organized by NSS (National Service Scheme) Unit of VISTAS, Chennai in collaboration with IAPA (International Alliance for the Prevention of AIDS) on 05/07/2019 in the University Premises. IAPA branches in the US and in India are mission focused in preventing the global spread of HIV through education and volunteerism. The aim of this programme was to give classroom awareness to the students on Prevention of HIV/AIDS.

The Program was inaugurated by the Registrar of the University Dr. A. R. Veeramani. Followed by the Inauguration, Dr. P. Jagadeesan, Assistant Professor & NSS coordinator gave the welcome address. IAPA members delivered a special lecture on the prevention of

HIV/AIDS to the student-volunteers.

400 NSS Volunteers were involved in this programme and they were taught to create awareness on the prevention of AIDS. Along with the IAPA members of about 25 foreign volunteers, our NSS Volunteers actively participated in the classroom awareness programme where they addressed the key issues involved in HIV/AIDS and the organizations involved to protect and prevent AIDS Patients.

Students were exposed to facts such as HIV spreads only in certain body fluids from a person who has HIV. The person-to-person spread of HIV is called HIV transmission. Some of the body fluids that spread HIV include blood, semen, pre-seminal fluids, rectal fluids, vaginal fluids, and breast milk.

1000 Students were benefitted out of this awareness programme since the volunteers went class-to-class and shared the methods involved in the prevention of HIV using Charts and Discussions. Students interacted and clarified their doubts to the IAPA Volunteers. The entire programme was monitored by the NSS Programme officers along with the NSS volunteers who took part in the event.

REF.: Notification by Govt. of India under the Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003.

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Govt. of India has enacted Rules to take preventive health care, the Rules ban the use of Smokeless Tobacco Products among them.

The children below 18 years of age who constitute majority of our population are adversely affected by the use of Tobacco Products. The studies says that the children fall into trap of Tobacco Products due to "Peer Pressure." This is an opportunity for Scout/Guide Movement to create awareness among the children below the age of 18 years to keep themselves away from Tobacco.

The Advisory issued by the Govt. of India is as under:-.

"It may be noted that the Government of India has already banned certain kinds of smokeless tobacco products like Gutkha, Chewing tobacco through the notification issued under the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006. The Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003 (COTPA 2003) has been notified/implemented to discourage the use of tobacco products. Section (4) of the Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003 (COTPA 2003) prohibits smoking in public places. Section-(6) of COTPA, 2003 mandates that no person shall sell, offer for sale, or permit sale of, cigarette or any other tobacco product to any person who is under 18 years of age and in an area within a radius of one hundred yards of any educational institution. However, under the extant Rules there is no provision for complete ban on all tobacco products.

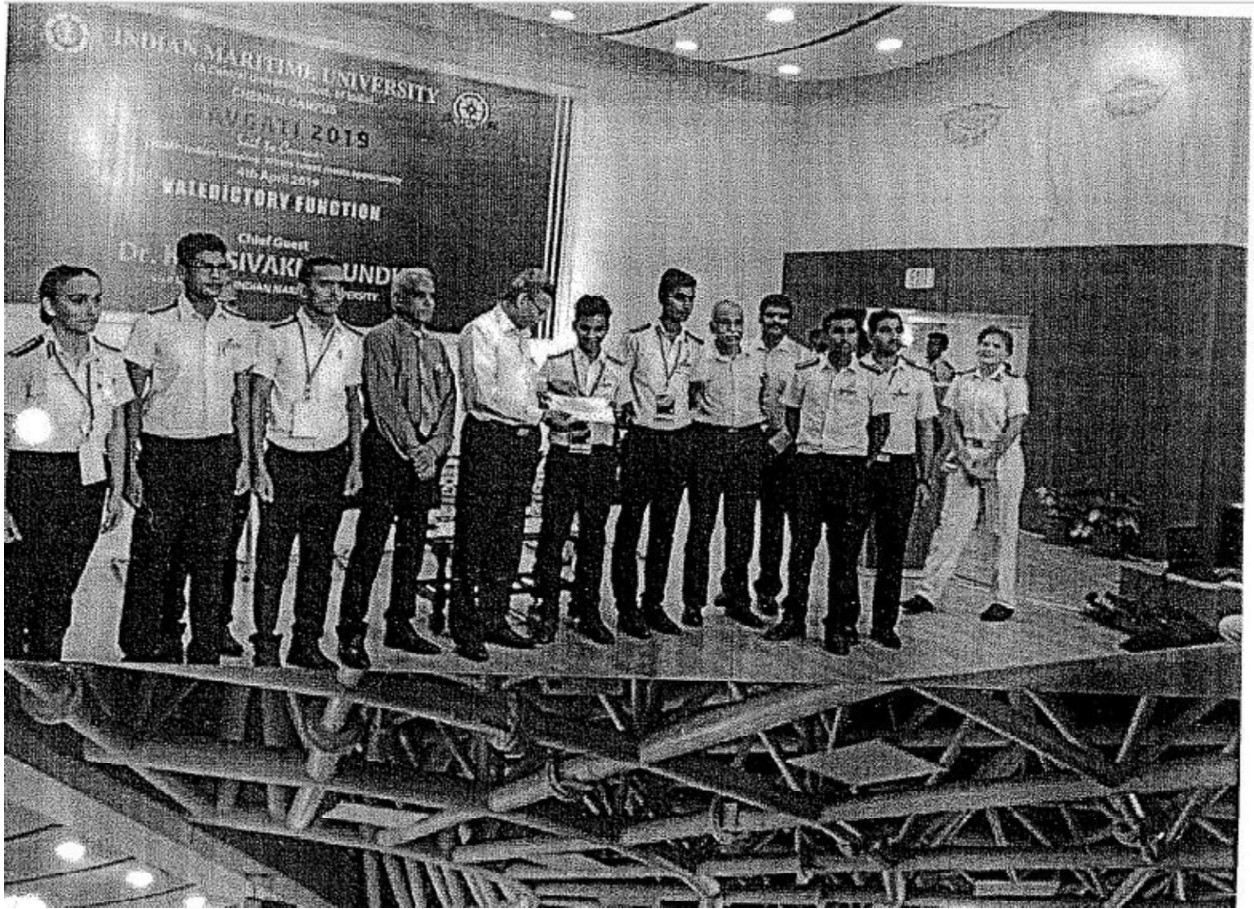
